

The Award

The award of the Prime Minister's National Medal for Science and Technology is intended to highlight the importance of the application of science and technology in the promotion of national development in Jamaica.

Nominators

Nominations are invited from members of the scientific, technological and engineering community, as well as members of the public in general. Nominators should normally be persons who wish to honour deserving citizens of Jamaica.

Submission of Nominations

Two hard copies of the duly completed nomination form, along with additional relevant information, should be submitted to the Chairman of the Advisory Board on the Award of the National Medal of Science and Technology.

- Nominations can be made by institutions or individuals and should be accompanied by at least three letters of recommendation.
- The application should clearly identify the elements of the candidate's work which are to be considered in terms of eligibility for the award, as well as details of the impact of this work on the economic, cultural and social development of Jamaica.
