

Emergency Contract Award for Procurement of Generators (Phase 1 and 2)

In response to the devastation caused by Hurricane Melissa in October 2025, the Ministry of Industry, Investment and Commerce (MIIC) – Jamaica’s Business Ministry developed a Business Restoration Plan (BRP) which was subsequently approved by the Cabinet. The BRP is designed to accelerate economic recovery and minimize disruption to supply chains across the seven (7) most affected parishes. In light of the widespread disruption in electricity supply which significantly affected local economic activity and negatively affected the supply of basic essential items, the MIIC undertook emergency procurement in phases to acquire generators for distribution to MSMEs in order to drive business continuity and faster local economic recovery. These MSMEs are key community-based business entities that foster local/domestic economic activity, employment and critical supply of basic essential items.
